PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the young people of Minnesota feel the necessity to face the trying problems of our great state and nation, not just with lip service, but also by giving of themselves in both time and talent, and

WHEREAS, the Minnesota Teen Corps feels that the most important action is for them to go where the financial fruit of their labor has gone and, therefore, will work with the recipient people of the Minneapolis Inner City and of Appalachia in creating a better society of understanding for mankind, and

WHEREAS, the success of this project has depended not only upon the energy and desire of these one-half million young people, but upon the cooperation and concern of businessmen and residents throughout this state, and

WHEREAS, with these young people and their ideals go the hopes and dreams of citizens throughout this great state,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold L. Vander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, March 29, 1968, as

"MINNESOTA TEEN CORPS CIVIC PROJECT DAY"

in Minnesota, and urge that all citizens enthusiastically support its projects and goals.
