PROCLAMATION

- WHEREAS, our Nation, like no other, is a melting pot of the religious faiths of the world; and
- WHEREAS, one of the greatest strengths of our Nation is the freedom it provides every individual to worship according to his own beliefs; and
- WHEREAS, Mrs. Stella Marion Kroll of St. Paul, present Minnesota Mother of the Year, has come before me with an appropriate petition on behalf of the American Mothers Committee, Incorporated, seeking Minnesota participation in a National Prayer Vigil; and
- WHEREAS, it has been truly said that no power on earth is as great as the power of prayer, and certainly never before have the prayers of our people been more urgently needed than in today's troubled world,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the date of Sunday, October 6, 1968, as

"PRAYER DAY"

in Minnesota, and I urge all citizens to join, in their own respective faiths, with the Mothers of America, in the observance of this significant effort to renew peace on earth and good will among all men.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twelfth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, and of the State the one hundred eleventh.
