WHEREAS, on May 11, 1970, the State of Israel will observe the 22nd Anniversary of its establishment; and

WHEREAS, Israel has opened wide its doors to the persecuted and displaced Jews of many lands giving them the opportunity for new life, and has been a source of pride to Jews throughout the world; and

WHEREAS, Israel has shared the benefits of its knowledge and experience with the less developed countries of Asia, Africa and Latin America by extending to those countries the benefits of its knowledge and experience; and

WHEREAS, in the 22 years of its existence Israel has demonstrated its striving to build an ethical and democratic society which can serve as a model for other countries to follow; and

WHEREAS, a common bond of values and ideals exists between Israel and the United States;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 10-16 as

ISRAEL INDEPENDENCE WEEK

I congratulate the State of Israel and bid all my fellow citizens to join in this historic occasion of the 22nd Anniversary of its founding.
