- WHEREAS, for the first time in history, sales of America's snack food favorite, Potato chips, will reach the one-billion dollar mark, indicating a tremendous popularity of the product as well as added prosperity for Minnesotans, and;
- WHEREAS, the nation's Potato chip manufacturers annually use more than three billion pounds of potatoes, employing thousands of citizens and bolstering the economy of the State and the United States,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold Levander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1970, as

POTATO CHIP MONTH

in Minnesota, and urge all of our citizens to mark this observance, acknowledging the sterling contributions of this industry to Minnesota.
