Considering it a privilege to serve in your State, I am



I do hereby recognize him as such, and declare him free to exercise and enjoy such
functions, powers, and privileges as are allowed to the Consuls General of
the most favored Nations in the United States.

In testimony whereof, I have caused these Letters to be made Patent, and the Seal of the
United States to be hereunto affixed.

Done at the City of Washington this seventh day of December
in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy and of the
Independence of the United States of America the one hundred and seventy fifth.




