



EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE  
CITY OF MANKATO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UN-  
INCORPORATED, UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEED-  
ING TWO HUNDRED ACRES, ABUTTING UPON THE

Amending Section 1, paragraph two thereof, as follows:

In line one by deleting the words and symbol "Southeast

In line five by deleting the word "forty" and substituting  
in lieu thereof the word "eighty".

ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF MANKATO TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNPLATTED LANDS NOT EXCEEDING TWO HUNDRED ACRES, PURSUANT TO M.S.A. SECTION 414.03, SUBDIVISION 2, AND ALL LAWS AMENDATORY AND SUPPLEMENTARY THERETO, AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE MUNICIPAL COMMISSION.

The City of Mankato, Minnesota, does ordain:

I. A Petition has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Mankato, Minnesota by Alphonse Trip of the County of Blue Earth, State of Minnesota, as the owner of the following described property to have said land included in the City of Mankato, Blue Earth County, Minnesota, to-wit:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section Seventeen (17), in Township One Hundred Eight (108) North of Range Twenty - SIX (26) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, which lies East of the center of the Highway running through said forty, known as "Agency Road", except therefrom any Highway thereon and except 17.71 Acres of the State of Minnesota on which is located the Minnesota Highway Department Building, said tract to be annexed containing 4.73 Acres.

II. The quantity of land embraced within the foregoing description is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres and is not within the corporate limits of any city or village and is contiguous to and abutting upon a portion of the southeasterly boundary of the City of Mankato, Minnesota; and is bounded on the North by Hoffman Road, on the West by Agency Road, and on the East by Trunk Highway No. 22. That said City of Mankato, Minnesota is an incorporated city having a population of not less than 10,000 nor more than 25,000 persons, to the last census. That it appears from the records of the Clerk of the City of Mankato, Minnesota, that copies of the petition asking for annexation were filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Mankato Township Town Board, and the Blue Earth County Board, and that more than fifty days have elapsed since said filing and that no objections to said annexation were submitted.

III. The City Council of Mankato, Minnesota, hereby determines that the annexation of the above described property will be to the best interests of that municipality and of the land affected; and that the above described tracts or parcels of land are so contiguous and property to be subjected to city government and are hereby annexed to and declared to be an addition to the City of Mankato, as effectively as if it had originally been a part thereof and the corporate limits of the City of Mankato, Minnesota are hereby extended to include said property.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the County Auditor, and the Secretary of State, and this ordinance takes effect ten (10) days after its passage and publication and upon the filing of certified copies, as herein provided.


