WHEREAS: Minnesota is one of America's greatest food producing states providing abundant qualities of wholesome food; and

WHEREAS: assurance of wholesome quality foods is provided through various programs of the Minnesota Department of Agriculture and other state agencies; and

WHEREAS: there still remains human nutritional deficiencies despite the agricultural abundance from our farms; and

WHEREAS: changing nutritional needs throughout the cycle of life require greater family awareness of the importance of proper nutritionally balanced diets; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Dietetic Association recognizes the importance of proper diet and good nutrition to the physical well being of our citizenry and supports educational activity designed to increase public understanding and awareness of the significance of good nutrition to the home, to the state, and to the nation,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of February 28 - March 6, 1971

"NUTRITION WEEK"

in the State of Minnesota.
