- WHEREAS: more Minnesotans each year are turning to boating as a form of recreation and relaxation and
- WHEREAS: boating is especially important to a land of 10,000 lakes and
- WHEREAS: the need for boat safety and boat safety education grows more acute as every year about 1300 lives are lost in boating accidents and
- WHEREAS: Congress by a joint resolution asked that a week be set aside as National Safe Boating Week and
- WHEREAS: the President has designated the week beginning July 4, 1971 as National Safe Boating Week

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby designate the week of July 4 - 10, 1971 as

SAFE BOATING WEEK

in Minnesota and I urge all who use Minnesota lakes and waterways to learn these skills essential to their own safety and the safety of others and to apply them carefully.
