

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, essential legislation to provide for the operation of State Government in Minnesota for the next biennium has not been acted upon by the Legislature; and,

WHEREAS, the time permitted by law for passage of such legislation during the Sixty-Seventh Session of the Legislature has expired and an extraordinary session is therefore created;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby summon you, the members of the Legislature, to convene in Extra Session on Tuesday, May 25, 1971, at 10 o'clock in the morning on that day at the Capitol in St. Paul, Minnesota.

It is my earnest request that only major legislation to cover the needs of the people of Minnesota be considered in this Extra Session and that the Legislature conclude its work as quickly as possible. Gladly the passage of tax and finance legislation that will substantially reduce the property taxes of citizens throughout the state is of first importance.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capital this 23rd day of May in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-one, and of the State, the One Hundred Fourteenth.
