ORDINANCE

An ordinance extending the corporate limits of the Village of Cokato to certain unincorporated, unplatted land, not exceeding 200 acres in area abutting upon the village limits.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated January 20, 1971, requesting annexation of the property hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 22nd day of January, 1971; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is 2.91 acres of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of any incorporated city, village or town; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all owners; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from the Town Board, the County Board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut on the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the village limits at the west boundary thereof;

THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF COKATO, ORDAINS:

Section 1. The Village Council hereby determines:

- (1) That the annexation will be to the best interests of the village and of the territory affected;
- (2) That the territory described herein abuts upon the village limits and is about to become suburban in character;
- (3) That none of the said property is now included within the limits of any city, village or town.

Section 2. Territory annexed.

The corporate limits of the village are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows, and the same is hereby annexed to and is included within the village as effectively as if it had originally been a part thereof:

The South 33-1/3 rods of the East 10 rods of the SW1/4 of the NE1/4 of Sec. 33, Twp. 119, Sg. 28, containing approximately 2.91 acres.

Section 3. Filing.

The Village Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Secretary of State, and the County Auditor of Wright County, Buffalo, Minnesota.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication, and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
