The territory involved consists of the following:


All that part of the West 330 Feet of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30), T30N, R20W, Washington County, Minnesota, lying westerly of the centerline of Mid Oaks Avenue North.

The property is adjacent to the City of Stillwater and said lands are unplatted and used for agricultural purposes. The petition is in proper legal form and sets forth the information required in Minn. Stat. 414.06 and upon the files and records, the Minnesota Municipal Commission being fully advised in the premises.

IT IS ORDERED: That the foregoing described real property be, and the same hereby is, detached from the City of Stillwater and made a part of the Township of Stillwater, Washington County, Minnesota, the same as if it had originally been made a part thereof.


