ORDINANCE #516

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A PORTION OF THE NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF THE NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 41, RANGE 21, PINE COUNTY, MINNESOTA, TO THE VILLAGE OF HINCKLEY

The Village Council of Hinckley ordains:

Section I. WHEREAS, Gerald J. Von Rueden and Dorothy Von Rueden, his wife, are the owners of the following described premises located in the County of Pine, State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:

That part of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter, Section 25, Township 41, North, Range 21, West, described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of said Northeast Quarter; thence East along the North line of said Section 25, 437 feet to the point of beginning; thence West along the North line of said Section 25, a distance of One Hundred Seventy-six feet; thence South parallel to the West line of said Northeast Quarter 210 feet; thence East parallel to the North line of said Northeast Quarter a distance of 176 feet to the West to the right-of-way line of U.S. Interstate Highway No. 35; thence North along said highway right-of-way a distance of 210 feet, more or less to the point of beginning; subject to Trunk Highway 48 over the North 50 feet thereof.


SECTION II. WHEREAS, said above described premises are unplatted and do not exceed two hundred acres and are solely owned by said Gerald J. Von Rueden and Dorothy Von Rueden, who have petitioned the Village Council of the Village of Hinckley to have such land annexed to and included within the municipal limits of the Village of Hinckley, which is an abutting municipality.

SECTION III. WHEREAS, copies of the Petition have been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission, the Town Board of Hinckley Township, the County Board of Pine County and more than sixty days have elapsed and no written objections have been filed with the Minnesota Municipal Commission to said annexation.


SECTION IV. WHEREAS, the Village Council of the Village of Hinckley finds that annexation of the above described premises to the Village of Hinckley is to the best interests of the Village of Hinckley and of the premises affected.

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED, That the Village Council of the Village of Hinckley pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Annotated 414.033 (Subd. 5) does hereby annex said above described lands and premises to the Village of Hinckley and the Clerk of the Village Council of the Village of Hinckley is hereby directed to forthwith send copies of this Ordinance to the Minnesota Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Town Clerk of the Township of Hinckley, the Pine County Auditor, and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
