

"Whereas the Board of Directors of this
Corporation in the forenoon of this 23rd day of
April A.D. 1883 at a meeting of said Board
duly adopted a resolution in the words and
figures following to wit:—"Resolved by the
Board of Directors of The Duluth and Iron
Range Railroad Company That the act of the
Legislature of the State of Minnesota entitled—
"An act to amend and continue the act of the
Legislature of this State approved March Ninth
(9th) one thousand eight hundred and seventy
five relating to the Duluth and Iron Range
Railroad Company." — Approved March Fifteenth
(15th) A.D. 1883, be and the same is accepted by
this Corporation and all and singular other
provisions of said legislative act are hereby
declared to be binding and obligatory upon this
Company" — As appears by the record and
minutes of said Board now hereafter filed.
Now therefore be it resolved by the Stockholders
of said The Duluth and Iron Range Railroad
Company duly convened that the foregoing
resolution of acceptance is in all respects
approved and confirmed."

It is hereby certified that the above
and foregoing resolution was duly and man-
ningly adopted by the Stockholders of The
Duluth and Iron Range Railroad Company
at a meeting of said Stockholders duly convened
in the Village of Duluth on the (26th) Twenty
eighth day of April A.D. 1883 and that the
