

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS: there are more than 130,000 servicemen and women living in Minnesota who completed their military service during the period of the Vietnam conflict and have now returned to civilian life; and

WHEREAS: these returning servicemen and women deserve every opportunity that a grateful nation can provide; and

WHEREAS: these veterans must be given opportunities for employment as well as training and education which will prepare them for future roles of responsibility and leadership in our communities; and

WHEREAS: our Federal, State and Local government agencies and departments and our private employers are sponsoring "Job Fairs" for veterans on May 1, throughout Minnesota to insure that these opportunities are fully available;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May, 1973 as

"JOBS FOR VETERANS MONTH"

and call upon all citizens and private employers in our state to render every assistance and cooperation in developing training and employment opportunities for our veterans. We must make full use of the talents and ambitions of these fine young people.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-fourth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-three and of the State the one hundred and fiftieth.
