Dear Sir:

Please find enclosed an ordinance passed by the City of Anoka on October 4, 1971 and which became effective 30 days after its publication on October 8th. Said ordinance annexes 323.36 acres of land which the City of Anoka purchased from the State of Minnesota. This parcel lies north of the Anoka Senior High School, and between North 7th Avenue and the Railroad. The delay in notification of all appropriate jurisdictions and agencies was due to an oversight.

It is our understanding that, since the City of Anoka is sole owner of all property involved, no public hearing will be necessary. With the filing of copies of this ordinance to all appropriate State Agencies (enumerated below), the property is herewith annexed to the City of Anoka.

ORDINANCE NO. 495

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ANOKA CERTAIN UN-PLATTED LANDS SITUATED IN SECTION THIRTY (30), TOWNSHIP THIRTY-TWO (32) NORTH, RANGE TWENTY-FOUR (24) WEST, GROW TOWNSHIP, AND IN SECTION TWENTY-FIVE (25), TOWNSHIP THIRTY-TWO (32) NORTH, RANGE TWENTY-FIVE (25) WEST, RAMSEY TOWNSHIP, ANOKA COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

The Commission of the City of Anoka do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The City of Anoka, Minnesota, is the owner of the lands hereinafter described, which lands comprise a contiguous tract of land abutting the present territorial limits of the City of Anoka. The following lands are situated in Grow Township, Anoka County, Minnesota, and are described as follows:

The Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$), and the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty (30), Township Thirty-two (32) North, Range Twenty-four (24) West.

The following lands are situated in Ramsey Township, Anoka County, Minnesota, and are described as follows:

Government Lots One (1) and Two (2), Section Twenty-five (25), Township Thirty-two (32) North, Range Twenty-five (25) West.

Section 2. The lands described in Section 1 hereof constitute a contiguous tract of land comprising approximately 323.36 acres.

Section 3. The Commission of the City of Anoka hereby determines that the lands described in Section 1 are owned by the City of Anoka, abut the present territorial limits of the City of Anoka, and are hereby annexed, added to and made a part of the City of Anoka, Minnesota, as effectually as if they had originally been a part thereof.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect thirty (30) days from the date of publication and after the filing of a certified copy hereof with the Municipal Commission of the State of Minnesota, the Clerk of the Town of Ramsey, the Clerk of the Town of Grow, the Anoka County Auditor and the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.


