of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Deputy Attorney General to the Department of Revenue and fix his compensation at the sum of Twenty-Seven Thousand, Five Hundred (\$27,500) per annum to be paid from the appropriations made for said Department. Mr. Luther shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this appointment shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law. Said appointment shall take effect on the 9th day of January, 1974.
