

The Village of Birchwood does hereby certify as follows;

That a Special Election was duly called and held in and for said Village on the 21st day of Sept. 1921, to determine the following question, namely "Shall the Village of Birchwood constitute a separate election and assessment district?"; that the votes cast upon said question were duly certified to the council of said Village by the Judges and Clerk of said election; that the council of said Village thereafter and within the time prescribed by law, duly met as a canvassing board, and canvassed the returns of said election, and the result of said election was, and the said council of said Village, acting as a canvassing board as aforesaid, did duly declare the result of said election to be as follows:

The total number of votes cast at said election was Fifty-one (51); that of said number Fifty-one (51) voters voted "YES" on said question, and no voters voted "NO" on said question, and that the said question was carried by more than a majority of the votes cast at said election; that the aforesaid result of said election is hereby certified to you for your action thereon pursuant to law.
