

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF  
THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
THE COUNTY OF CLAY, STATE OF  
MINNESOTA:

The undersigned legal voters residing within the territory and upon the lands hereinafter described make this petition to your honorable body to appoint a time and place when and where the voters actually residing upon said lands may vote for or against the incorporation of said lands as a village, under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter nine (9) of the General Statutes of Minnesota, 1913, and all acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto.

The lands proposed to be incorporated are situate, lying and being in the township of Holy Cross, in the County of Clay and State of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit: beginning at a point on the section line between sections twenty-one (21) and twenty-eight (28), township 137, range 48, 1500 feet east of the quarter section post on said section line, thence north and parallel with the north and south quarter section line running through said sections 21 and 28, 1327.5 feet, thence west parallel to the said section line between said sections 21 and 28, 3000 feet, thence south and parallel with the north and south quarter section line running through said sections 21 and 28, 2655 feet, thence east and parallel with said section line between sections 21 and 28, 3000 feet, thence north and parallel with said north and south quarter section line running through sections 21 and 28, 1327.5 feet to place of beginning, and containing portions of the southeast and southwest quarters of said section 21 and portions of the northwest and northeast quarters of said section 28, and embracing within its limits the lands platted into lots and blocks by the plats of the Original Townsite of Comstock and of Askegaard's First Addition to Comstock, which said plats have been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State of Minnesota, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for the County of Clay and State of Minnesota in which said lands lie.

That the unplatted parts of such territory adjoin the platted portions thereof and are so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government.

And we further certify that a census of the resident population within said territory has been taken and is hereto attached, showing the number of 142 persons actually resident therein.

The name of the village proposed to be incorporated shall be "Comstock".
