

Proclamation

WHEREAS: children and adults in Minnesota need a helping hand with special therapeutic and educational services; and

WHEREAS: such services contribute to greater independence and achievement for those so handicapped, thus increasing the number of useful, dignified human lives, the right of the citizens to provide such services voluntarily is a sacred privilege of a free society; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota affiliate of the National Easter Seal Society for Crippled Children and Adults, is equipped to provide specialized therapeutic services of rehabilitation and educational aid most efficiently and effectively; and

WHEREAS: restaurants, hotels, drug stores and coffee shops have joined with the Minnesota Restaurant Association to implement "Coffee Day" with all proceeds from coffee sales and coffee day buttons going to aid the service programs of the Easter Seal Society;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, November 22, 1974 as

COFFEE DAY FOR EASTER SEALS

and urge all citizens to lend a helping hand to our children and adults in need of speech and language services.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and seventy-four and of the State the one hundred and sixteenth.
