WHEREAS: January 29th marks the 2nd anniversary of a no draft environment; and

WHEREAS: since that date the United States Army has created and maintained an all Volunteer Force; and

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota has contributed significantly to that Volunteer Force by the enlistment of young citizens; and

WHEREAS: those young citizens have helped to create and maintain a mentally and physically more superior Army than ever before;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of February as

ARMY RECRUITING MONTH

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to pay tribute to the noble objectives of the United States Army Recruiting Command.
