AS: the Gopher State Cat Club, Inc., a subsidiary organization of the American Cat Fanciers Association, will sponsor "The Sixteenth Annual Royal Merit Sextuple Championship Cat Show" on April 26 and 27, 1975; and

AS: this year a new classification has been added to the championship classes for the benefit of the eligible household pets from American Cat Fancier Association shows during the calendar year, May 1, 1974 - April 30, 1975, for the purpose of crowning the King & Queen of Minnesota Household Pet Cats; and
