



Proclamation

- REAS: the National Mothers of Twins Club was organized in Canton, Ohio in 1930; and
- REAS: the purpose of MOTC is to broaden the understanding of those aspects of child development and rearing which relate to twins; and
- REAS: this is accomplished through interchange of information among parents, educators, doctors and others with a direct interest and appropriate experience; and
- REAS: there are now 224 member clubs in 44 states representing more than 8,000 members; and
- REAS: there are five Mothers of Twins Clubs in the State of Minnesota; and
- REAS: the Southern Minnesota Mothers of Twins Clubs are sponsoring the state's first workshop in Rochester on April 26, 1975;

THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, April 26, 1975 to be

MOTHERS OF TWINS DAY

Minnesota.
