WHEREAS: Women in Community Service (WICS) is a volunteer organization that works in conjunction with JOB Corps and Manpower Inc., to help young women who have dropped out of high school; and

WHEREAS: WICS continues its help until the young women have established themselves as self-sustaining persons in the community; and

WHEREAS: women from five coalitions, namely, Church Women United, National Council of Negro Women, National Council of Jewish Women, National Council of Catholic Women and American GI Forum Auxiliary work together in this enterprise; and

WHEREAS: a special day has been designated by Women in Community Service to celebrate the tenth anniversary of their program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, April 23, 1975 as

WICS DAY

in Minnesota, and call upon all Minnesotans to recognize these dedicated volunteers in this worthwhile venture.
