

CERTIFICATION OF CHANGE OF PARTY NAME

We, respectively, the undersigned Chairman and Secretary of the State Convention of the Republican Party, of Minnesota, do hereby certify that on the 15th day of November, 1975, the following resolution was agreed upon by the majority of the Convention.

BE IT RESOLVED: That Section 1 of Article 1 of the Constitution of this party be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"Section 1: NAME The name of this party shall be the Independent-Republicans of Minnesota."

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That other provisions of the Constitution of this party containing the name 'Republican Party of Minnesota' be, and the same hereby are, amended to reflect the change of name of this party to 'Independent-Republicans of Minnesota'".

"BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That for the purpose of filing this document and for all subsequent legal matters including designation on the ballot, the party shall heretofore be known as 'Independent-Republican'".

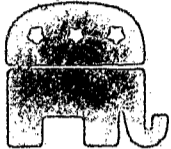

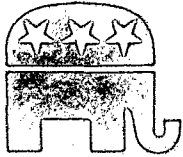

Pursuant to laws of the State of Minnesota, the Republican Party of Minnesota, and by virtue of the authority of the State Central Committee, a State Convention of the Republican Party of the State of Minnesota, is hereby called to convene at 9:00 o'clock a.m., Saturday, November 15, in the Stewart Hall Auditorium on the St. Cloud State University Campus in the City of St. Cloud, Minnesota for the purpose of:

1. Consideration of a revised State Constitution, which will either mandate or make permissible a change of the primary political unit from county to Senate or House Districts.
2. U. S. Senate Report.
3. Issues Forums.
4. Keynote Address - The Honorable Nelson A. Rockefeller, Vice President of the United States.
5. Transact such other business as may properly come before the convention.

Issued at 555 Wabasha, St. Paul, Minnesota 55102, this 15th day of October, 1975, by the order of the State Central Committee and the State Executive Committee of the Republican Party of the State of Minnesota.

Data from a survey conducted in September and October of this year indicates that independent voters would be strongly inclined to vote for Republican candidates if they were identified as "Independent-Republican" candidates. The Executive Committee weighed this information and other pertinent factors and recommended that the State Convention consider such a party name change.

To properly present this consideration before the State Convention on November 15, the Executive Committee passed the following motion at a special meeting of the Committee held October 29.

"The State Republican Executive Committee recommends that the Republican State Central Committee ratify the amended call for the State Convention to be held in St. Cloud on November 15, 1975 to include as the purpose to consider changing the name of the Republican Party of Minnesota to "Independent-Republican." The State Central Committee will consider the motion at its meeting on November 14 in Brown Hall on the St. Cloud Campus.

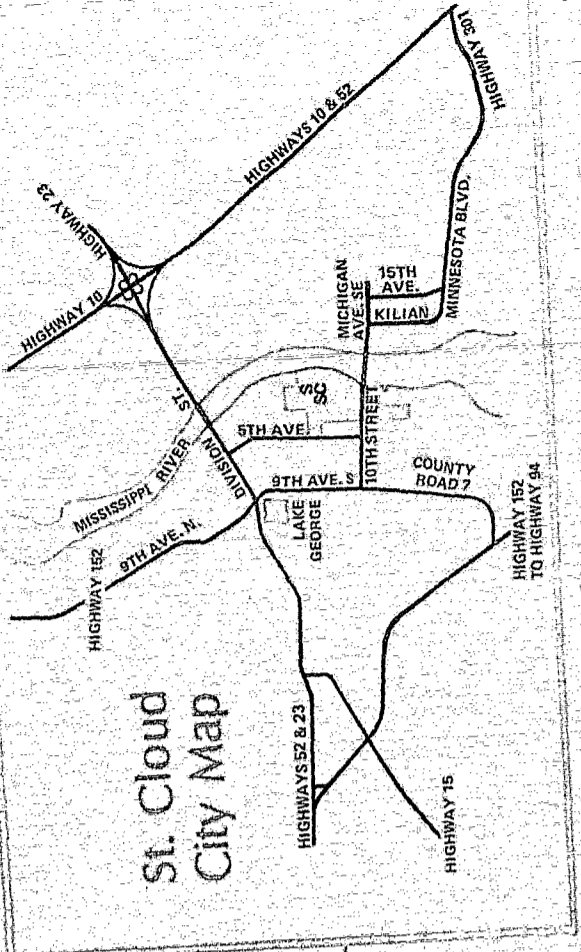
