I have the honor to inform your Excellency that the Royal Hungarian Government has favored me with the appointment of Consul of that Kingdom with residence at this City and with territorial jurisdiction in the following States:

Arizona, Arkansas, California, Colorado, Idaho, Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Louisiana, Minnesota, Mississippi, Missouri, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, Oklahoma, Oregon, South Dakota, Texas, Utah, Washington, Wisconsin, Wyoming; in the counties of Gogebic, Ontonagon, Houghton, Keweenaw, Iron, Baraga, Dickinson, Marquette, Menominee, Delta, Alger, Schoolcraft, Luce, Mackinac and Chippewa in the State of Michigan; in the Territory of Alaska; and in the Philippine Islands and Hawaii.

Having received the customary Exequatur issued by His Excellency the President of the United States of America, deigning to recognize me in my official capacity, I have entered upon the discharge of my official duties.

I avail myself of this opportunity to offer to you the assurance of my highest consideration.
