

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING LAWS 1973,  
CHAPTER 123, AS THE GOVERNING LAW OF THE  
CITY OF BISCAY

WHEREAS: Pursuant to Minnesota laws 1973, Ch. 123, Art. V Sec. 5, Subd. 2, the City of Biscay will cease to be governed by it's present governing law based on the optional village plan, and be governed by the Uniform Code of Municipal Government on July 1, 1975, unless an earlier change is provided for by resolution, and

WHEREAS: It is in the best interest of the citizens and city government that this transition occur as soon as possible, now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED - by the council of the City of Biscay, that upon filing of this resolution with the McLeod County Auditor, the Minnesota State Auditor and the Minnesota Secretary of State, which filing is hereby directed to be made by the clerk, the City of Biscay shall henceforth be governed pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 412.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the regular city election shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in every even numbered year, beginning with the 1974 election. Also: That the terms of the Mayor and the two councilmen whose current terms will expire on the first business day of January, 1976, shall be extended to the first business day of January, 1977; and those offices shall be filled at the 1976 city election, along with the term of the councilman whose term would normally expire on the same first day of January, 1977. Of these three councilmen who are to be elected at the 1976 election, the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes shall then serve for terms of four years, commencing with the first business day of January, 1977, and the one receiving the third highest number of votes, shall serve for a term of two years from that same date. The Mayor shall be elected for a two year term at each such election, commencing in 1976, and at each subsequent biennial election, two councilmen shall be elected for four year terms.

This resolution was adopted by the Biscay village council on the 13th day of May, 1975, councilmen Garoutte, Frahm and Mc Guire being present and each voting aye.
