



Proclamation

WHEREAS: 200 years have proven the value of early education as to what alcohol and other narcotics are and do, particularly in the field of lawlessness involving youth; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota citizens, who realize the present day need of giving people the benefit of all possible aid and guidance, are sincerely interested in such education; and

WHEREAS: we note with grave concern the record of increasing alcoholism in our state; and

WHEREAS: the matter of abstinence from beverage alcohol and narcotics demand serious attention by parents, teachers, and all others whose activities bring them into contact with youth;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 25 through May 1st, 1976, as

YOUTH TEMPERANCE EDUCATION WEEK

and urge that citizens in churches, schools, clubs, and as individuals, join in the observance of youth temperance education during this designated week; and further urge all Minnesotans to become alert to said education as a year around project.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourteenth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-six and of the State the one hundred eighteenth.
