



Proclamation

WHEREAS: the value of professional photography in the promotion of the State of Minnesota and its tourist industry, and to individuals and families of Minnesota as a historical and pictorial record of its citizens, is well known; and

WHEREAS: the National Professional Photographers of America Association, in concert with the Minnesota Professional Photographers Association, have selected the month of June to call attention to their profession; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Professional Photographers Association has urged all of its members to recognize the national and regional programs;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of June 1976 as

PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHERS MONTH

in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to familiarize themselves with the professional photographers efforts on behalf of Minnesota, its tourist industry, and the history of its development as recognized by the professional camera.
