WHEREAS: it is evident that to meet the serious challenges our society will encounter in the future, it is vital to have the creativity and skills of the dedicated women who devote themselves to community needs; and

WHEREAS: the members of the National Council of Jewish Women have made outstanding leadership efforts to achieve equal rights and opportunities for women;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 24 - 31, 1977 as
