



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Concrete and Masonry Day honors more than 8,000 persons who are actively involved in the concrete and masonry industry in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Masonry Institute in conjunction with the Minnesota Concrete and Masonry Contractors Association are conducting the fifth annual project to promote public awareness of the versatility, economy and aesthetics of concrete and masonry products in meeting community needs; and

WHEREAS: on Sunday, June 26, 1977, the grand prize in Duff's Golf and Tennis Tournament will be a 1,344 square foot, all-masonry energy-efficient home; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Masonry Institute and the Minnesota Concrete and Masonry Contractors Association have helped provide labor and materials in the construction of this energy-efficient home;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, June 26, 1977, as

CONCRETE AND MASONRY DAY

in Minnesota.
