ORDINANCE NO. 128

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF NORWOOD TO INCLUDE CERTAIN UNINCORPORATED UNPLATTED LAND NOT EXCEEDING 200 ACRES IN AREA ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS.

WHEREAS, a certain petition dated November 23, 1976, requesting annexation of the territory hereinafter described was duly presented to the council on the 3rd day of December, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the quantity of land embraced within the area described in the petition and bounded as described is less than 1 acre of unplatted land, no part of which is included within the limits of an incorporated city, village or borough; and

WHEREAS, the petition was signed by all the owners of said lands; and

WHEREAS, no objections to the annexation have been received from county board, or the governing body of any municipality whose boundaries abut upon the boundaries of the land to be annexed; and the town board has withdrawn its objection, and the municipal board has permitted the City to proceed.

WHEREAS, no hearing is required by law on the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the land described in the petition abuts upon the City limits at the East boundary thereof; the council of the City of Norwood, Minnesota, ordains:

Section 1. The City Council hereby determines (1) that the annexation will be to the best interests of the City and of the territory affected; (2) that the territory described herein abuts upon the City limits and is urban or suburban in character; and (3) that none of said territory is now included within the limits of any city, village or borough.

Section 2. Territory Annexed. The corporate limits of the City are hereby extended to include the unplatted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the City as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

All that part of the Northeast Quarter of Section 14, Township 115, Range 26, lying Southerly of the centerline of State Trunk Highway No. 212, easterly of the Westerly right-of-way of the Chicago and Northwestern Railway, and Northerly of the centerline of old State Highway No. 212.

Section 3. Filing. The City Clerk is hereby directed to file certified copies of this Ordinance with the Minnesota Municipal Board, the Secretary of State, County Auditor, and County Recorder.

Section 4. Effective date. This ordinance takes effect upon its passage and publication and the filing of the certified copies as directed in Section 3.
