WHEREAS: more than 80,000 mobile homes are listed on current Minnesota tax rolls and more than 200,000 Minnesotans are living in mobile homes; and

WHEREAS: the State of Minnesota has become a major manufacturer of mobile homes for the Upper Midwest; and

WHEREAS: the mobile home industry is clearly an important segment of our life and economy in Minnesota constituting a free enterprise answer to the need for non-subsidized, low-income housing; and

WHEREAS: the mobile home industry has set out and accomplished the task of manufacturing mobile homes that offer the same reliable construction and comforts of site-built homes; and


WHEREAS: mobile home occupants comprise a section of all walks of life from students to teachers, from trades persons to professional and from young marrieds to retired couples;

MOBILE HOME WEEK '78


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to mark its celebration.
