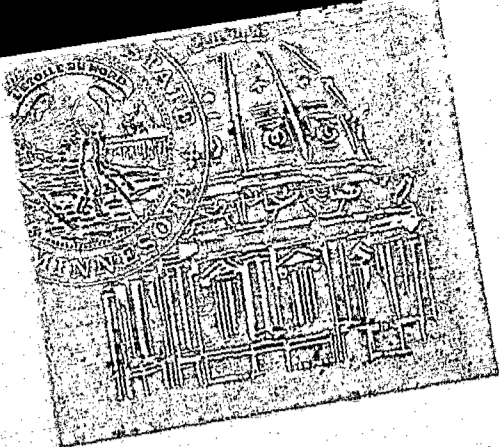


Proclamation



WHEREAS: transportation is the lifeline that ties together the production, marketing and distribution that determines the worth of our state and national economy; and

WHEREAS: the facilities and services that comprise our transportation system vitally affect not only our economy but the environmental and social fiber of our total existence; and

WHEREAS: transportation in all of its forms is a major user of our energy and other natural resources, as well as a major contributor to the development of those resources;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 14 through May 20, 1978 to be

NATIONAL TRANSPORTATION WEEK

in Minnesota, and call upon all citizens to observe the period with especial concern for safe, economical use of our transportation facilities, and upon all providers and planners of Minnesota transportation to take special care and exercise respect for the state's social, environmental and economic well-being.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-seventh day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred seventy-eight and of the State the one hundred twentieth.
