WHEREAS: racial discrimination remains a serious problem in America requiring corrective attention in all facets of our public life; and

WHEREAS: a body of laws has been developed to effectively combat racial discrimination in the courts; and

WHEREAS: the due process of law is an expensive procedure requiring extensive legal talent and resources; and

WHEREAS: the NAACP Legal Defense and Educational Fund, Inc. (LDF) provides resources and leadership in the struggle for equal human rights for black Americans and other racial minorities; and

WHEREAS: the Minnesota Steering Committee of the LDF is sponsoring an in-service training conference on civil rights law for attorneys in the Twin Cities area June 9-10 at Hamline University in St. Paul; and


WHEREAS: any proceeds from the conference remaining after paying its expenses will be contributed for the general support of the LDF program;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of June, 1978 to be

LEGAL DEFENSE FUND MONTH


in Minnesota, and urge all citizens to support the activities of the LDF.
