



# Proclamation

WHEREAS: O R T (Organization for Rehabilitation through Training) has, as the vocational education program of the Jewish people, dedicated itself for the last century to the operation of a global network of vocational and technical installations; and

WHEREAS: Women's American O R T has pledged itself to enlarging the worldwide O R T system, to doubling the O R T-Israel network, to completing the spectacular O R T School of Engineering at the Hebrew University, to confronting and defeating anti - Semitism, to backing Soviet Jewry and human rights everywhere, to supporting the people of Israel in their search for peace and security, to promoting the growth of the new Bramson O R T Training Center in New York City, and to advancing the cause of quality, relevant education here and abroad; and

WHEREAS: Women's American O R T, the largest group in the 40 nation O R T family has pledged itself to enroll tens of thousands of new members in order for the organization to achieve its goals; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April 26, 1979, to be
