GOVERNOR'S ORDER NO. 8, EXTENDING ADDITIONAL PROTECTION
TO DEER IN CHISAGO COUNTY.


Whereas, it has been represented to me that deer in Chisago County, Minnesota, are in danger of extermination, and

Whereas, the Game and Fish Commissioner has investigated and finds that unless this species be protected by a close season the supply of deer in Chisago County will become exterminated,

Now, Therefore, I, J.A.O. Preus, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of and pursuant to authority vested in me by Section 134, Chapter 400, S.L. 1919, do hereby order that no deer be taken in the County of Chisago, State of Minnesota, during the open season of 1924.

This order shall remain in force until the close of the regular session of the Legislature unless sooner revoked or modified.
