WHEREAS, the said Henry N. Benson has served as a County Court Judge of said Nicollet County Court for the past eighteen (18) years; and


WHEREAS, the said Henry N. Benson has satisfied the necessary legal requirements established under Minnesota Statutes Sections 490.121 to 490.132 for such retirement at the close of business on November 30, 1979.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Henry N. Benson, Judge of the County Court, County of Nicollet, State of Minnesota, said retirement to be deemed to become effective at the close of business on November 30, 1979. He shall become entitled thereafter to such retirement compensation as provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490. I hereby direct that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.
