WHEREAS: The family comprises the basis of our great State and Nation, and must be preserved and strengthened if we are to improve the quality of life in daily society; and

WHEREAS: Good, wholesome entertainment is essential to the well-being of the family, and provides an increase in the bond of togetherness and sharing; and

WHEREAS: The name Bugs Bunny has become synonymous with the highest form of entertainment for children of all ages throughout the world; and

WHEREAS: "Bugs Bunny in Space" will appear at the Met Center, Bloomington, Minnesota, January 10 through January 13, 1980, and at the Duluth Arena Auditorium from January 3 through January 6, 1980;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Albert H. Quie, Governor of the State of Minnesota do hereby proclaim the weeks of January 3 through January 13, 1980 as
