

GOVERNOR'S ACCEPTANCE CERTIFICATE
OF REAL PROPERTY GIFT MADE BY
HERBERT C. GARVIN AND WIFE TO
STATE OF MINNESOTA.

WHEREAS, under warranty deed dated January 17th, 1925, and acknowledged on January _____, 1925, Herbert C. Garvin and Louise D. Garvin, his wife, as a gift, did grant and convey to the State of Minnesota all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of Winona and state of Minnesota, described as follows, to-wit:


Commencing at a point nine hundred and twenty-five (925) feet south of the north quarter section corner of section thirty-four (34), township one hundred seven (107) north, of range seven (7), thence south one hundred sixty-four (164) feet, thence west three hundred and sixty-six (366) feet, thence south fifty-six (56) degrees west, along the line of "HIGH ROAD" one hundred and thirty-five (135) feet, thence north two hundred and forty-four (244) feet, thence east four hundred and seventy-nine (479) feet containing two (2) acres, more or less.


AND WHEREAS, the purpose of said gift was and is that said land so conveyed shall be owned, held, occupied, and used by the state in connection with Winona State Teachers' College and by the students and faculty of said college for recreational purposes in connection with and as a part of the premises known as Garvin Heights Park, heretofore conveyed by the grantors to the State of Minnesota.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Theodore Christianson, as governor of the State of Minnesota, under and by virtue of chapter 464, Laws 1909, and in consideration of the premises, do hereby accept of the grant or conveyance of said lands, which tract shall hereafter be a part of said "Garvin Heights Park".
