WHEREAS: WOMEN PLAY A MOST IMPORTANT PART IN THE INSURANCE INDUSTRY AND IN THE RELATED FIELDS OF FIRE PREVENTION, SAFETY, AND CRIME PREVENTION; AND

WHEREAS: THESE WOMEN DESERVE COMMENDATION AND RECOGNITION FOR THEIR OUTSTANDING ACCOMPLISHMENTS IN THIS TRULY PROFESSIONAL FIELD; AND

WHEREAS: THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF INSURANCE WOMEN (INTERNATIONAL) NOW HAS A MEMBERSHIP OF OVER 22,000 WOMEN;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF MAY 18 THROUGH MAY 24, 1980 TO BE

NATIONAL INSURANCE WOMEN'S WEEK

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TWENTY-THIRD DAY OF APRIL IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY-SECOND.
