



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE GAME OF CHESS REQUIRES A GREAT DEAL OF THOUGHT AND THE ABILITY TO MAKE LOGICAL AND STRATEGICAL MOVES; AND

WHEREAS: THE GAME OF CHESS IMPROVES THE MIND BY HELPING A PERSON CONCENTRATE AND TO THINK IN A MORE ORDERLY AND LOGICAL WAY; AND

WHEREAS: UNDER TITLE VII OF PUBLIC LAW 92-318, FEDERAL AID MAY BE APPROPRIATED TO CONDUCT CHESS PROGRAMS IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS; AND

WHEREAS: CHESS IS ALREADY BEING TAUGHT IN SOME PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND COLLEGES; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA KINGSMEN CHESS ASSOCIATION, INC. HAS CONDUCTED THE MINNESOTA CHESS DAY TOURNAMENTS SINCE 1977, AND WILL HOST A CHESS TOURNAMENT IN DULUTH ON OCTOBER 4, 1980 CALLED "MINNESOTA CHESS DAY CHESS PLAY";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM OCTOBER 4, 1980 TO BE

MINNESOTA CHESS DAY

IN MINNESOTA, THE FOURTH SUCH RECOGNITION IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS TENTH DAY OF SEPTEMBER IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY SECOND.
