WHEREAS: PROFESSIONAL SECRETARIES CONTINUE TO PLAY A VITAL ROLE IN EVERY FIELD OF ENDEAVOR IN MINNESOTA; AND

WHEREAS: THE SKILL, KNOWLEDGE AND DIPLOMACY OF PROFESSIONAL SECRETARIES ARE NEEDED TO AN EVEN GREATER EXTENT AS OFFICES HAVE BECOME MORE COMPLEX; AND

WHEREAS: MORE PROFESSIONAL SECRETARIES ARE NEEDED IF OFFICE PRODUCTIVITY IS TO KEEP PACE WITH THE DEMANDS OF SOCIETY;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF APRIL 19 THROUGH 25, 1981 TO BE
