



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA ZOOLOGICAL GARDEN WAS ESTABLISHED TO PROVIDE FOR CONSERVATION, RESEARCH, EDUCATION AND RECREATION; AND

WHEREAS: THE MINNESOTA ZOO IS BREEDING AND MAINTAINING BEAUTIFUL WILDLIFE IN NATURAL SETTINGS FOR THE ENTERTAINMENT AND EDUCATION OF FAMILIES; AND

WHEREAS: THE STATE AND CITIZENS OF MINNESOTA HAVE BUILT A ZOOLOGICAL GARDEN THAT IS TAKING ITS PLACE PROUDLY IN THE GREAT WORLD TRADITION OF PUBLIC SERVICE ZOOS; AND

WHEREAS: AMERICA'S PUBLIC ZOOS HAVE BECOME THE MOST FREQUENTLY USED SOURCE OF CONTACT BETWEEN PEOPLE AND WILDLIFE;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE DAYS OF MAY 1 AND MAY 2, 1982 TO BE

MINNESOTA ZOOGOER DAYS

IN MINNESOTA AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME. FURTHER, I URGE CITIZENS TO SUPPORT AND PARTICIPATE IN EDUCATIONAL AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES IN ZOOS THROUGHOUT MINNESOTA DURING THAT TIME.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, WE HAVE HEREUNTO SET OUR HANDS AND CAUSED THE GREAT SEAL OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA TO BE AFFIXED THIS SEVENTH DAY OF APRIL IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-TWO, AND OF THE STATE THE ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-THIRD.
