



Proclamation

WHEREAS: THE NATION WILL OBSERVE NATIONAL TRANSPORTATION WEEK, MAY 16-21, 1982, IN RECOGNITION OF THE ESSENTIAL ROLE OF TRANSPORTATION IN OUR COUNTRY'S ECONOMY AND OUR PROSPERITY; AND

WHEREAS: WOMEN IN RAILROADING HAVE MADE VITAL CONTRIBUTIONS IN THEIR DAILY WORK, BOTH IN PEACE AND WAR, TOWARD THE SERVICE OF THEIR INDUSTRY TO THE PUBLIC; AND

WHEREAS: ONE OF THE MAJOR OBJECTIVES OF THE MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF RAILWAY BUSINESS WOMEN, OVER AND ABOVE THEIR SERVICE TO THE INDUSTRY, HAS BEEN TO STIMULATE GOOD WILL FOR THE INDUSTRY AND A GREATER PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE RAILROADS' ESSENTIALITY TO OUR NATION'S ENERGY CRISIS; AND

WHEREAS: THE NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF RAILWAY BUSINESS WOMEN, MINNESOTA CHAPTERS HAVE COOPERATED ACTIVELY IN THIS PARTICULAR WEEK IN MANY WAYS, COMBINING GOOD WORKS IN THEIR COMMUNITIES WITH SPECIAL PROJECTS;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM WEDNESDAY, MAY 19, 1982 TO BE

RAILWAY BUSINESS WOMEN'S DAY

IN MINNESOTA, AND HAVE ASKED LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR LOU WANGBERG TO PREPARE THIS PROCLAMATION FOR MY SIGNATURE AND DISSEMINATE THE SAME.
