WHEREAS: RESPIRATORY THERAPY IS RECOGNIZED AS ONE OF THE FASTEST GROWING ALLIED HEALTH FIELDS; AND

WHEREAS: OVER 800 RESPIRATORY THERAPY PRACTITIONERS IN MINNESOTA DELIVER LIFE SUSTAINING AND THERAPEUTIC CARE TO PATIENTS SUFFERING FROM LUNG AND HEART DISORDERS; AND

WHEREAS: THESE HEALTH CARE PROFESSIONALS ARE TO BE COMMENDED FOR THEIR SERVICE TO THE CITIZENS OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, ALBERT H. QUIE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 19 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 26, 1982 TO BE

RESPIRATORY THERAPY WEEK
