FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW,
AND ORDER

On July 29, 1982, the Minnesota Municipal Board received resolutions from the City of Minnetonka which requested the detachment of certain property and the City of Wayzata which requested the annexation of the same territory pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 414.061.

After review of the resolutions, the Minnesota Municipal Board hereby makes and files the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. That a resolution supporting detachment of certain properties was received from the City of Minnetonka and a resolution supporting annexation of said property was received from the City of Wayzata.
2. The resolutions contained all the information required by statute including a description of the territory proposed for detachment and annexation which is as follows:

Section 5, Township 117, Range 22; Part of Southwest 1/4 of Northeast 1/4; described as follows: Commencing at the most Northerly corner of Lot 10, thence Southwesterly 170 feet, thence Southeasterly 404 1/10 feet, to a point 170 feet Southwesterly of a point in Northeasterly line of Lot 10, distance 406 feet Southeasterly from beginning, thence Northeasterly 170 feet, thence Northwesterly 406 feet to beginning.

3. The area proposed for detachment is situated within the City of Minnetonka and abuts the municipal boundary of the City of Wayzata.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Minnesota Municipal Board duly acquired and now has jurisdiction of the within proceeding.
2. An order should be issued by the Minnesota Municipal Board concurrently detaching and annexing the area described herein.


ORDER
