



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The citizens of Central Minnesota have recognized a need for a Metro Multi-Purpose Arena; and

WHEREAS: This facility will be centered in a large metropolitan area, thus it will provide a structure to accommodate community activities such as conventions, conferences, large and small group activities that will be so important to the communities that it will serve; and

WHEREAS: The proposed facility will be located central to Minnesota's Agricultural activity and encompass a three-county area and will provide space for regional agricultural gatherings, activities and displays; and

WHEREAS: The need encompasses children's hockey and figure skating, adult and family recreational skating, broomball, interscholastic and intercollegiate skating; and

WHEREAS: There is an increasing and critical demand for specific winter activities such as community, agriculture and recreational events; and

WHEREAS: Community involvement with time and money have indicated a positive response toward reaching the goals of the Metro Multi-Purpose Arena;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, March 17, 1983, to be

BENTON COUNTY METRO MULTI-PURPOSE ARENA DAY

in Central Minnesota.
