



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Americans have more political and economic freedom than any other people on earth; and

WHEREAS: A cornerstone of American freedom is the right to private ownership of real property; and

WHEREAS: Members of the Minnesota Association of Realtors are committed to the widest possible ownership of property and to the exercise of the rights of ownership by any citizen; and

WHEREAS: Realtors and realtor associates across the state are asking fellow citizens to join in celebrating this freedom on Sunday, April 10;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, April 10, 1983, to be

MINNESOTA REALTORS HOMEBUYER'S SUNDAY

in Minnesota, and I encourage all citizens to join with the membership of the Minnesota Association of Realtors in celebrating the right to private ownership of real property with the intent that the freedom will continue for posterity.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-three, and of the State the hundred twenty-fifth.
