WHEREAS: 100,000 Minnesotans have some form of epilepsy; and

WHEREAS: 60 percent of those persons who have epilepsy are elementary school age or younger; and

WHEREAS: In Minnesota, there is approximately one child in every other classroom with epilepsy; and

WHEREAS: Epilepsy is the second most common neurological disorder;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of November, 1983, to be

EPILEPSY MONTH

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I urge citizens to learn more about this condition and assist those who have epilepsy to succeed in our community.
