



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The percentage of adults in our population continues to grow; and
- WHEREAS: Education for all people constitutes one of America's noblest contributions to civilization; and
- WHEREAS: Society is undergoing increasingly rapid modification, necessitating each person's understanding of an adaptability to change; and
- WHEREAS: The progress and well-being of the citizens of Minnesota depends to a great extent upon their mastering a changed world through continuing education - a process which is lifelong; and
- WHEREAS: Private, voluntary, religious, recreational, business, and industrial agencies realize the importance of adult education as evidenced by their establishment and support of a variety of adult continuing education programs - many of which are models for the nation; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Legislature and the Minnesota Board of Education have recognized by their continued support of programs, the value of public adult education; and
- WHEREAS: The Minnesota Association for Continuing Adult Education has established the third week in October as "Adult Education Week";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of October 16 through October 22, 1983, to be
